'' It's well below the average wage, isn't it?'' the singer said '' I 'd be better off working at a fast—food restaurant.''

Badly Drawn Boy, whose real name is Damon Gough, performed in his famous wooly hat in the cold outside Waterloo station for the video, due to be released in three weeks with single All Possibilities.

Five hidden cameras recorded the reactions of passers –by ,most of whom failed to recognise him ." A lot of people didn't believe it was me or didn't know who I was , "he said . " When I first stood there, there was a long line of people waiting for a bus. No one batted an eyelid." Gough, who won the 2000 Mercury Music Prize for his debut album The Hour of
